

Thesis Examination Submission

1. With the approval of their supervisor, students must complete the *Thesis Title Submission* via CyberCampus V2.
2. Only students who have received approval (“Eligible for Examination”) from their Thesis Supervisor through CyberCampus V2 are permitted to upload their thesis manuscript in the *Thesis Examination Submission* menu.
3. Students must upload their thesis manuscript through CyberCampus V2 in the *Thesis Examination Submission* menu within the specified deadline.
4. Students must complete the supervision history with both Supervisor 1 and Supervisor 2, and subsequently request approval from the supervisors through the *Thesis Supervision History* menu.
5. Students must contact Supervisor 1 to obtain approval for examination eligibility.
6. Students must proceed with the *Thesis Examination Submission* process by uploading the thesis file (including the ethics approval document and the statement confirming completion of data collection).
7. Students must inform the Head of the Study Program that the thesis examination submission has been completed on CyberCampus V2.
8. Students must wait for the verification process on CyberCampus V2.
9. Students must contact Supervisor 1, Supervisor 2, and the thesis examiner to confirm their availability for the scheduled examination.
10. Students must reserve a room according to the examination schedule agreed upon by Supervisor 1, Supervisor 2, and the examiner.
11. Students must contact the Academic Division to request the issuance of the official thesis examination invitation letter.
12. Students must provide printed copies of the thesis manuscript along with the invitation letter to Supervisor 1, Supervisor 2, and the examiner no later than one day before the thesis examination.

Thesis Defense Procedures

1. The thesis defense is conducted offline at the Faculty of Nursing.
2. Students must wear a white shirt, a white hijab for those who wear one, black trousers or a black skirt (fabric material), and the university blazer.

3. The Head Examiner will announce the defense results and the revision deadline before the session concludes.
4. Students are permitted to record and request a copy of the assessment notes from the Examination Committee after the defense is completed.
5. Students must complete all required revisions within one week after the examination.

Submission of the Revised Thesis Manuscript

1. Students must revise their thesis manuscript according to the feedback provided by the Examination Committee and consult with each examiner as needed.
2. Students must prepare a revision form listing the revised pages and chapters, and provide comments on all revised sections when submitting the revised version to the examiners.
