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#### **I. INTRODUCTION**

Nursing Study Program is an educational program aimed at producing professional nurses. In relation to this objective, students must be introduced to real clinical and field experiences through a Nursing Clinical Practice program. Nursing clinical practice is an active learning activity that enables students to gain learning experiences in real practice settings. This practical learning experience is implemented to provide students with opportunities to enhance cognitive, communicative, and psychomotor skills in the areas of basic nursing, patient safety, and occupational health and safety in nursing.

#### **II. OBJECTIVES**

After completing the Nursing Clinical Practice program, students are expected to be able to apply nursing care in a real setting to patients with problems within the competency areas of basic nursing, patient safety and occupational health and safety in nursing, effective and appropriate nursing communication, as well as health education and health promotion. This includes integrated courses in Pediatric Nursing, Maternity Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing, and Palliative and End-of-Life Nursing, as well as Emergency, Critical Care, Gerontic, Family, and Community Nursing, using an appropriate nursing process approach, implementing proper nursing communication, and providing health education and health promotion.

#### **VIII. Participants :**

Participants of the Nursing Clinical Practice Program in Semester VI of the 2024/2025 academic year are students of the Nursing Study Program, Faculty of Nursing, Universitas Airlangga, Track A, Class of 2022, totaling 228 students (list of student group names attached).

#### **IX. Nursing Clinical Practice Schedule**

The Nursing Clinical Practice for students of the Nursing Study Program, Faculty of Nursing, Universitas Airlangga, Track A, Class of 2022, is conducted in each rotation for **3 weeks in an offline setting at Universitas Airlangga Hospital, nursing homes (Panti Werdha), and community health centers (Puskesmas) in the Surabaya City area.**

## **X. Practice Regulations**

- 1) Student attendance during online practice must be 100%.
- 2) One day prior to practice, students must contact their supervisor to request a case to be used in preparing the preliminary report.
- 3) Each student must prepare a preliminary report according to the practice area to be undertaken.
- 4) The student supervision process by lecturers consists of three activities: preconference on Monday according to the agreed time and media between supervisor and students, task supervision (conference), and postconference at the end of the week or on Friday.
- 5) Each student must prepare a nursing care case report (assessment format, data analysis, priority diagnosis list, and interventions) based on the case provided by the supervisor (one case for 2–3 students).
- 6) Each group is required to conduct health education once per practice week. The topic and educational media are determined by the academic supervisor. Students are required to consult the Lesson Plan (SAP) with the supervisor.
- 7) Each group must submit weekly attendance records to the person in charge of the clinical practice course (PJMK).

**Practice at Universitas Airlangga Hospital sub-competencies in Emergency Nursing, Critical Care Nursing, Pediatric, Maternity, Medical Surgical, and Basic Nursing.**

- 1) Offline practice is conducted at Universitas Airlangga Hospital in units designated by the hospital. Students are **REQUIRED** to participate in the pre-clinical orientation (Pradik) organized by the hospital. Students who do not attend the Pradik are not permitted to participate in the Nursing Clinical Practice.
- 2) In addition to academic supervisors and clinical lecturer supervisors, students are also assigned clinical supervisors (Clinical Educators/CE) from Universitas Airlangga Hospital.
- 3) Students must comply with all practice regulations established by Universitas Airlangga Hospital.
- 4) Students are required to wear scrub uniforms during practice, along with appropriate attributes and equipment in accordance with hospital regulations.  
Notes : Critical Care Units (ICU, ICCU): gowns must be worn.  
Recovery Room (RR) : students must bring separate clothing and hijab for use inside and outside the RR. Female students should wear loose hijab; male students must wear head coverings. Each student must bring personal sandals labeled with their name.
- 5) The supervision process at Universitas Airlangga Hospital is conducted offline by clinical lecturer supervisors and clinical nurse supervisors. Outside the offline schedule at the hospital, supervision is conducted by academic supervisors for Critical/Emergency Nursing.
- 6) The supervision process consists of three activities: **preconference** on **Monday** according to the agreed time and media, task supervision (**conference**), and **postconference** at the end of the week or on Friday.
- 7) Each student must prepare a nursing care case report (assessment format, data analysis, priority diagnosis list, interventions, implementation, and evaluation) according to the managed case provided by the academic or clinical supervisor (one case for 2–3 students).

- 8) Each student must be able to collaborate with supervisors and the healthcare team during practice implementation.
- 9) Students are required to submit daily activity reports signed by the clinical or academic supervisor at the end of each week.
- 10) Each group must submit weekly attendance records to the PJMK of the clinical practice.

## **XI. EVALUATION**

### **1. Structure Evaluation**

- 1) Students are able to participate in Nursing Clinical Practice in units in accordance with the learning objectives.
- 2) Students are required to bring supporting equipment for practice implementation, even though some equipment is available in the units.
